We often go for prayer walks on our university campus, parks, government housing units, hospitals and around neighborhoods, to look for opportunities to share the gospel. We often visit the Hispanic refugees who are currently living in downtown El Paso, and we serve them by sharing the gospel and praying for them. We also provide warm meals, clothes and toys. We invest time with them in fellowship to share the love of Christ with them.
