That is where Abigail and I met, as we both were in Central Asia serving refugees together. We were married there and continued to serve side by side overseas until June 2021 when we, along with our son, transitioned to the United States. We became legal guardians of three of my siblings when American troops evacuated Afghanistan, instantly making us a family of six. Since transitioning to the U.S., we have also welcomed two daughters, bringing our total to eight in our loving family.

About My Ministry

We are currently serving in Nashville, reaching out to the local Afghan community of nearly 4,000 refugees. Utilizing our language skills and cultural knowledge, we build friendships, evangelize, and disciple as we share the love of Christ.
