We were married there and continued to serve together overseas until June 2021 when they, and our young son, transitioned to the United States. We became legal guardians of three of my siblings when American troops evacuated Afghanistan, instantly making them a family of six.

We will be walking with refugees as they transition into life in the United States. We will be building friendships, evangelizing and discipling as we live life with them.
