About My Church Plant

Farm & Family Missions Church is located in Bow, Wash. We are a Wednesday evening church comprised of people who have a love of the farm and family lifestyle, are on mission to show the goodness of God by meeting needs in our community and the world, and carry out our commission to make disciples of ALL nations.

We have already planted a church in Kitale, Kenya (Farm & Family Missions Kenya). We help to empower them by directly funding a three-acre maize field to support orphans and widows. We also partner with Harvest Hands Ministries in Faisalabad, Pakistan, providing direct support to Christians who are persecuted and enslaved at a brick kiln. We provide food, Bibles and discipleship as we work to purchase their freedom.

We have plans to plant another local church in Sedro Woolley, Wash., in the coming months.
