About My Ministry

I facilitate religious ministry and care for and advise the 3,000 Marines and Sailors at the Marine Corps' Basic School (TBS) and Weapons Training Battalion. TBS is a six-month, entry-level school that all U.S. Marine Corps officers attend directly after Officer Candidate School, the Naval Academy or Reserve Officer Training Corp (ROTC).

For three years, I am setting the standard for these Marines of what to expect from their chaplain and how to utilize their chaplain when they get to their first duty station.
