About My Church Plant

Upon saying "yes," we had within a week two families who were not aware of our "yes" to NAMB, approach us about starting a church. We began the first Sunday in March 2020, met three weeks before being shut down because of the COVID pandemic, met online, re-started the last Sunday in May and are closing out 2020 with approximately 45 people in regular attendance.

I provide the church with a steady diet of expository preaching. I continually find ways to disciple the body. We started Sunday School in August, and we have a weekly, mid-week Bible study to provide encouragement.

I believe today's church needs much more Jesus and much less world.
