In lieu of a grand-opening service, we partnered with sister churches to give away more than 10,000 meals and thousands of supplies out of our church parking lot and impacting hundreds of homes in the days following the storm. Family Church's property also experienced damage which caused us to move locations to repair our space for nearly a year. As of December 2023, we're finally back ministering out of our location. Our community is ripe for the harvest and after this investment. We're beginning to see a great response!
