## **About My Church Plant**

God has called our family to plant a multiplying, multiethnic church in Langley, which is part of metro Vancouver. Langley is one of the most rapidly growing cities in British Columbia. The fastest growing religious preference is "no religion," while an increasingly high number of immigrants from around the world contribute to growing Sikh, Muslim and Buddhist populations. It is common during one trip to a community centre to meet young families from India, Korea, China, Russia, Jordan, Turkey and Ukraine.

Since the onset of COVID-19, we have been meeting on Zoom with a small group of people. God has been faithful to us through the pandemic. We are seeing God reap a harvest and expand His kingdom in Willoughby. We are now meeting weekly at a Holiday Inn, and God is stirring us up to rebuild spiritual lives and build up this church.
