This is the pattern we find in the Bible from the creation of humanity in the image of God to the final vision of a new heaven and a new earth: cosmic renewal through individual renewal.

Romans 8 has been particularly influential to this vision. All of creation is groaning as it waits to be liberated from its bondage to decay, and that will only happen when the children of God are glorified—that is, when they share in the reign of King Jesus. We seek the renewal of people into the image of Jesus as we anticipate the day when that transformation is complete and creation has been restored.
