About My Church Plant

We are working with NAMB's director of the Dakotas to create a cohort of sending churches and rural missions in South Dakota and North Dakota to advance the gospel. We are developing training, tools, mentorship and community empowerment to empower sending churches to adopt rural areas. As God moves, we hope to create a network of sending churches and missionaries focused on rural areas to advance the kingdom to see the joy in being called to small places for the big gospel.
