About the Family

I am a born and raised Colorado native from the Boulder County area. My wife, Sara, grew up all over the place as a military girl, but considers Colorado Springs her hometown. We met during our undergraduate studies at Colorado Christian University through a short-term missions trip to Utah. We've been married since 2016 and have three wonderful kids: Peter, Theo and Penny!

Since the beginning of our relationship, a deep desire for the Mormon (LDS) people to come to know the true gospel of Jesus Christ had consistently turned our eyes toward the lost in Utah. After finishing my M.Div. at Denver Seminary, we moved to Utah in 2019 as NAMB missionaries and were able to plant Mosaic Church in October of 2020 in Provo.

About My Church Plant

We planted Mosaic Church in the heart of downtown Provo in October of 2020. In Provo, 82% of the population are active members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (Mormons), 17.5% of the population are religiously unaffiliated, and fewer than 0.5% identify as evangelical Christians. With these statistics, Provo is the most unchurched metropolitan area in North America.

And although Provo has historically been a church planting graveyard, the Lord is doing something amazing through Mosaic Church right now. Our worship gathering has a weekly attendance of 100-130 people, and we have seen (and are seeing) many men and women leave the LDS Church and place their faith in the true Jesus!
