About My Ministry

Many of the women He places before me need an advocate to bring them the hope they can find in Jesus. I serve alongside the City of Anniston when the warming shelter is open and the Soup Bowl when they are closed for a break. I do this by building relationships with local churches. I also lead a discipleship group called D-Life. God has provided college students to lead Bible clubs in two of the Housing Authority communities, as well as a women's group in another community with a friend from another church. Building relationships with those He puts before me is the main part of my ministry here. I make myself available to Him for the one He has for me to bring Him glory.
