### About My Church Plant

All Saints Church is a scrappy multicultural church plant that exists to make disciples and plant churches. Our church is about one-third first generation Americans coming from countries like Trinidad, Dominican Republic, Lebanon, the Netherlands, Finland, Venezuela, Mexico and Ghana, just to name a few. The average age of our congregation is 27, and half are single. About 20 percent of our Sunday attendees are not Christians or not sure where they stand spiritually. We like keeping it that way. God's vision for All Saints Church is that it would be a catalytic movement of His grace that develops men and women to be trained and sent out to make disciples and plant churches. The goal is not to be the largest church in the Bronx, but to expand our reach to the corners of the world and to see His glory impact nations.
