About My Church Plant

From a young age, I felt God stirring my heart for ministry, but it wasn't until years later—through both struggles and God's grace—that I clearly sensed His call to preach the gospel and shepherd His people. Moving to Florida was a step of faith, but it confirmed that God was leading me to plant a new church.

Today, we are planting Kairos Church in Venice, a young and growing congregation centered on Jesus. Our heart is to reach second-generation Slavic families, immigrants and our neighbors with the hope of Christ. At Kairos, we want people not just to hear about Jesus but to experience His love through relationships, discipleship and community. Our prayer is that God would use this church to bring lasting change in our city and raise up a new generation of believers who live boldly for Him.
