About the Family

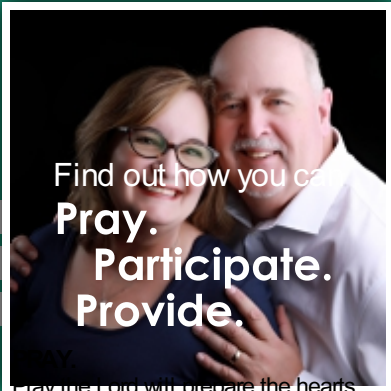
