About the Family

We are Jason and Mallory Parker. Originally from Lyman, S.C., we followed God's call to gospel ministry in Utah in 2023 after visiting with our church mission team.

I am a lead church planter with the North American Mission Board (NAMB). We are planting Redemption Church Bear River in Tremonton, Utah (1 hour north of Salt Lake). We love people and are passionate about sharing the life-changing good news of the gospel.

Utah is the most "religious" state in the country. About 70% of people identify with a religious affiliation. The overwhelming majority of those congregations are the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints (LDS).

Evangelical churches make up about 2% of total churches in Utah. That's why building up believers to go out and plant churches is so important here.

About My Church Plant

I have partnered with Redemption Family of Churches (North Davis, Ogden, North Ogden). Redemption's goal is to plant 20 churches by 2040.
