Washington, D.C., is home to between 4,000 and 6,000 Sudanese Muslims. They can be used by God to lead their own people to the freedom only Jesus can give. In the Lord's strength, I will be starting Bread of Life Church, and it will become self-governing, self-supporting and self-multiplying, both in America and abroad.
