About My Church Plant

Study after study reveals that the Denver metro area is one of the most post-Christian and unchurched area in the nation.

Just 10 years ago our Sending Church was a group of 30 people who committed to loving their neighborhood with the gospel. Today, we have grown into a vibrant community of several hundred believers who has planted more than 20 churches in the Denver area and beyond.

Our church plant desires to witness similar God-glorifying fruit by taking that same message of hope into a different part of Denver and transform it for generations to come.
