Also, every Tuesday at noon we support a ministry called "Bread of Life" where food baskets are shared with those in need. The objective is to engage with the community. We take advantage of the preaching of the gospel at every opportunity, and we have also had a response to the gospel, praise God. On Sunday mornings at 10:45, we meet at TBC Español for worship and Bible exposition and at 5:00 p.m. we meet for discipleship class.
