I'm from Honduras, Central America. I'm a Doctor in the fields of Orthopedics and Traumatology.

We came in 2019 with a firm desire to serve in a local church. God lead us to the North American Mission Board through Boris Alfaro. God opened doors to serve in the city of Springfield, and we started an Hispanic ministry with two families.

About My Church Plant

As I mentioned, we started our Hispanic ministry with two families (8 people) and with the support of the English congregation. God has shown His fidelity, and now we now have 82 members.

We have our services on Sunday mornings from 9:00 to 10:30, and our kids have Sunday School. We also have Bible study each Friday from 6:00 to 8:00 at the same time the youth have their meeting. We have Convene Services with the English congregation monthly.

We are an interesting Church. 8 countries represented. But we are one Church with an English Congregation. We met Sundays mornings and the last Sunday of the month we have combined services English-Spanish. We have Bible studies every Friday with delicious international food.
