## About My Church Plant

We have our services on Sunday mornings from 9:00 to 10:30, and our kids have Sunday School. We also have Bible study each Friday from 6:00 to 8:00 at the same time the youth have their meeting. We have mixed services with the English congregation quarterly.

We serve communities dinners the last Wednesday of each month. Our benevolence committee helps people in our community each Monday through our food pantry and clothes closet.

We are a family church who believes all of the English and Spanish are the same church.
