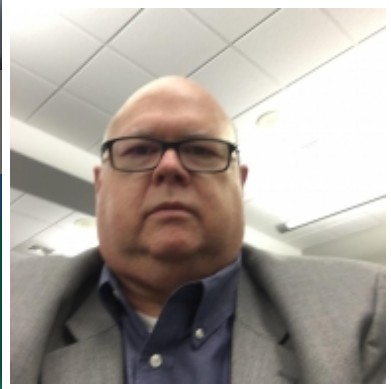
About the Family
