My time is spent helping people and sharing the gospel with them.

## About My Church Plant

Hallelujah Nepali Ministry seeks to reach the lost in the Greater Cincinnati area. We have a Sunday church service at Rolling Hills Baptist church, which is our sending church. We also have an after-school program where we help students with their homework and teach English as a Second Language (ESL). Our ministry center is open seven days a week to minister to the Nepali people living in the area.

Not only do we help students with after-school tutoring and ESL but we also offer a citizenship class to help Nepalis become U.S. citizens. We help with other needs that might arise since translation is a big need for many. Our church has women's and youth ministry that meet each week.
