About My Ministry

Restoration Church of Sanford, launched in January 2022 with the goal: "RESTORE all people from all walks of life back to God by grace through faith in Jesus Christ." We aim to reach the overlooked in society—the homeless, addicts, poor, non-English speakers, etc.

I relocated to this ministry in Sanford after I married Tim. Together, we help evangelize, disciple and counsel. I especially focus on reaching Hispanics. We help set up and tear down on Sundays at a local elementary school, reach out to visitors and participate in outreach. I also interpret the Sunday message for non-bilingual Spanish-speakers and share the gospel with those I meet on my own in the community. Not all Spanish/English speakers who are members are able to translate or have had ministry training and experience, so I can also disciple them along.
