We had the opportunity to visit the Portland area for the first time in June 2016, and we were immediately blown away by the majestic beauty here. About My Church Plant

We are striving to reach those who are native to the Pacific Northwest and to raise up co-laborers from among the harvest. We are currently involved in heavy outreach within our community (42,000 people within a five-minute drive, 60 percent white and 22 percent Hispanic). We are heavily involved at our elementary school (726 students, Spanish Immersion School with about 60 percent white and 40 percent Hispanic families). We are heavily involved on campus at Clark College (17,000 students, 49 languages represented).

We at River City Church have a vision to plant 32 churches in 20 years. River City Church will function as a training and development center from which church planting teams are raised up and sent out. We currently have several individuals being trained through our leadership development pipeline.
