About My Church Plant

At the same time, I've been training with NAMB/SEND Network to be a church planter.

These churches will be built on three core biblical values: Community (Acts 2:42-47), Confidence (1 Pet. 3:15-16), and Coaching (Matt 28:18-20; Eph 4:11-16).
